FINAL ORDER

- 4. Respondent is found to have violated section
 489.129(1)(d), Florida Statutes; section 24(2)(e), chapter
 75-489, Laws of Florida, as amended; and section 26129(b)(5), Pinellas County Code, on two separate counts.

THERFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

- 5. Respondent is hereby fined two consecutive fines of \$1,000.00, totaling \$2,000.00.
- 6. Respondent's license number I-CBC1251933 is suspended.

7. Respondent is ordered to timely satisfy the terms of any civil judgment obtained against Respondent as a result of any civil action arising from the facts of this case.
