This cause was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings where the assigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) J.D. Parrish, conducted a formal administrative hearing. At issue in this case is whether Respondent, Jean M. Duterne committed fraud, deceit, negligence, or misconduct in the practice of regulated activities under Chapter 493, Florida Statutes, and, if so, whether the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Licensing (the "Department") may deny the issuance of or revoke various licenses held by Respondent. The Department adopts the findings of fact set forth in the Recommended Order.


CONCLUSIONS OF LAW



This Order constitutes final agency action. Any party who is adversely affected by this Order may seek judicial review under Section 120.68, Florida Statutes. Such proceedings are commenced by filing a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Deputy Clerk of the Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services, Division of Licensing, Post Office Box 3168, Tallahassee, Florida 32315-3168; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal, accompanied by the applicable filing fees, with the First District Court of Appeal, or with the District Court of Appeal in the appellate district where the party resides. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days of the day this Order is filed with the Deputy Clerk of the Division.
