FINAL ORDER

By letter dated March 31, 2010, the Agency for Persons with Disabilities (APD) informed Angels of America, Inc., that it was terminating the Medicaid Waiver Services Agreement that it and Angels of America had entered into. Following the receipt of a request for an administrative hearing, the matter was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH). On May 26, 2010, APD moved to dismiss the proceeding on the basis that Petitioner had not shown that its substantial interests would be affected by the Agency's action. On June 9, 2010, the Administrative Law Judge entered an Order Relinquishing Jurisdiction and Closing File.

THEREFORE, based on the foregoing and being otherwise fully apprised of the premises, it is hereby ORDERED that the hearing request filed in the above-styled case is hereby DISMISSED and this case is CLOSED.
