FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Board (Board) pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on March 17, 2011, in Tampa, Florida, for the purpose of considering the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order (attached hereto as Exhibit 1) in the above-styled case. Petitioner was represented by LeChea Parson, Assistant General Counsel. Respondent was present.

Petitioner filed an Amended Administrative Complaint (Exhibit 2) against the Respondent alleging that Respondent violated provisions of the Electrical Contractors' Practice Act. Respondent disputed the facts alleged in the Amended Administrative Complaint and requested an evidentiary hearing before the Division of Administrative Hearings ("DOAH"). This matter was referred to DOAH and on October 20, 2010, an evidentiary hearing was held before the Honorable Eleanor M. Hunter, Administrative Law Judge. On January 4, 2011, Judge Hunter issued her Recommended Order.

Neither party filed exceptions to the Recommended Order.

After a complete review of the record in this matter, the Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The findings of fact set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated by reference herein.

2. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 489, Florida Statutes.

2. The conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated by reference herein.

RECOMMENDATION

Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Board determines that the dismissal of the Administrative Complaint as recommended by the Administrative Law Judge is appropriate and **ACCEPTED** the recommendation.
