BACKGROUND

This is a proceeding to determine whether the Hendry County Comprehensive Plan

Amendment 10-2, adopted by Ordinance 2010-14 on April 13, 2010, is "in compliance" with the

Community Planning Act, Ch. 163, Part II, Florida Statutes.

The Department, the County, and The Viera Company entered into a Stipulated

Settlement Agreement which required the County to adopt certain remedial amendments for the

10-2 amendment. The County adopted the 11-2 remedial amendment and the Department

subsequently issued a courtesy letter to the County on July 11, 2011, stating that the Department

has completed its review of the remedial amendment, the Department has reviewed the

amendment in accordance with the expedited state review process, and the Department has

identified no provision that necessitates a challenge pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida

Statutes.

No further remedial actions were required for the 10-2 amendment to be in compliance.

The Conservancy of Southwest Florida has dismissed its petition. The issues raised in this case

have been fully resolved. By Order in this case jurisdiction was relinquished to the Department

by the Administrative Law Judge, and the DOAH file was closed.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is ORDERED that the Hendry County 10-2 Plan Amendment adopted

by Ordinance 2010-14 on April 13, 2010, is "in compliance" with the Community Planning Act,

Ch. 163, Part II, Florida Statutes.
