FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the State of Florida, Department of Business and Professional Regulation ("Department"), for the purpose of considering Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Edward T. Bauer's Recommended Order, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A. Petitioner timely filed Petitioner's Exceptions to the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit B. Respondent did not file exceptions and did not file a response to Petitioner's exceptions.

After a review of the complete record in this matter, including consideration of the Recommended Order and Petitioner's Exceptions, the Department makes the following findings and conclusions:

EXCEPTIONS TO RECOMMENDED ORDER

1. Petitioner's Exception was considered and is GRANTED.

FINDINGS OF FACT

2. The ALJ's Findings of Fact as set forth in Exhibit A are approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference. These findings are supported by competent substantial evidence.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 3. The ALJ's Conclusions of Law as set forth in Exhibit A are approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference.
- 4. The Division is permitted to accept the ALJ's findings of fact, but reject the recommended penalty after review of the entire record. Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission v. Bradley, 596 So.2d 661 (Fla. 1992).

WHEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT:

- 1. Respondent shall pay an administrative fine of \$1,000.00 made payable to the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, Department of Business and Professional Regulation, 1940 North Monroe Street, Tallahassee, FL 32399, within thirty (30) days of the date of the filing of this Final Order with the Department's Agency Clerk.
- 2. Respondent's license is suspended for a period of one year from the date of the filing of this Final Order with the Department's Agency Clerk.
- 3. This order shall become effective on the date of the filing with the Department's Agency Clerk.
