FINAL ORDER

This matter appeared before the Board of Funeral, Cemetery and Consumer Services at a duly-noticed public meeting on February 3, 2011 in Tallahassee, Florida for consideration of a Settlement Agreement (attached hereto as Exhibit A) entered into between First Coast Funeral Home (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") and the Department of Financial Services (hereinafter referred to as "Petitioner") in the above-styled cause. Upon consideration of the Settlement Agreement, the documents submitted in support thereof, and being otherwise advised in the premises, it is hereby ordered and adjudged:

(1) The Board voted to reject the settlement agreement and made a counter offer which was verbally accepted by Respondent at said Board meeting.

(2) The terms of the accepted counter-offer are as follows:

a. All terms of the settlement agreement remain in place; and


b. If the Division of Funeral Cemetery and Consumer Services (the Division)

determines at any time that there is reasonable cause that unlicensed activity has occurred at the establishment, Respondent agrees that the Division may enter an emergency suspension order without further process.

This Final Order shall become effective upon filing with the Clerk of the Department of Financial Services.

NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS

PURSUANT TO SECTION 120.68 FLORIDA STATUTES, A PARTY WHO IS ADVERSELY AFFECTED BY THIS FINAL ORDER IS ENTITLED TO JUDICIAL REVIEW UNLESS WAIVED. PROCEEDINGS ARE GOVERNED BY THE FLORIDA RULES OF APPELLATE PROCEDURE. SUCH PROCEEDINGS ARE COMMENCED BY FILING ONE COPY OF THE NOTICE OF APPEAL WITH THE AGENCY CLERK OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCIAL SERVICES AND A SECOND COPY, ACCOMPANIED BY FILING FEES PRESCRIBED BY LAW, WITH THE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEALS, FIRST DISTRICT, OR WITH THE DISTRICT COURT OF APPEAL IN THE APPELLATE DISTRICT WHERE THE PARTY RESIDES. THE NOTICE OF APPEAL MUST BE FILED WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF RENDITION OF THE ORDER TO BE REVIEWED.
