## **FINAL ORDER**

- 1. On July 14, 2010, the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Division of Alcoholic Beverages and Tobacco ("Division"), issued an administrative action against Respondent.
- 2. On August 2, 2010, Respondent filed a timely request for hearing, citing disputed issues of fact.
- 3. The matter was forwarded to the Division of Administrative Hearings and assigned to Administrative Law Judge R. Bruce McKibben.
  - 4. Administrative Law Judge McKibben conducted a formal hearing on February 2, 2011.
  - 5. Administrative Law Judge McKibben issued a Recommended Order on May 12, 2011
