Administrative Law Judge recommends imposition of a fine of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500). I concur. Based on the foregoing, a fine of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) is imposed on the Respondent, Donald R. Derby. Payment in full of the fine is due within 15 days after the filing date of this final order.
