FINAL ORDER

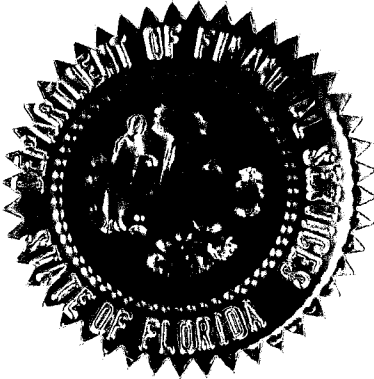
