FINAL ORDER

An Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings has entered an Order Relinquishing Jurisdiction and Closing File in this proceeding. A copy of the Order is attached to this Final Order as Exhibit A.

BACKGROUND

This is a proceeding to determine whether the City of Palm Coast Comprehensive Plan Amendment 10-D2, adopted by Ordinance 2010-14 on October 5, 2010, is "in compliance" with the Community Planning Act, Ch. 163, Part II, Florida Statutes.

The Department, the City, and Neoga Lakes, LLC, entered into a Stipulated Settlement Agreement which required the City to adopt certain remedial amendments in the related "Overlay" case, DOAH 10-9050GM. The City adopted the "Overlay" 11-R3 remedial

amendments and the Department subsequently issued a courtesy letter to the City on July 1, 2011, stating that the Department has completed its review of the "Overlay" 11-R3 remedial amendment, the Department has reviewed the amendment in accordance with the expedited state review process, and the Department has identified no provision that necessitates a challenge pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes.

No further remedial actions were required for the 10-D2 amendment to be in compliance. The issues raised in this case have been fully resolved. By Order in this case dated July 21, 2011, jurisdiction was relinquished to the Department and the DOAH file was closed.
