## FINAL ORDER AWARDING COSTS AND ATTORNEY FEES

On Friday, September 9, 2011, the Commission on Ethics met in public session and considered the Recommended Order (RO) of the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) of the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH) which was rendered in the above-referenced matter. Neither Bobbie Metz, the respondent in the underlying ethics complaint and the petitioner in this costs/fees matter (Metz), nor Shaun Myers, the complainant in the underlying ethics complaint and the respondent in this costs/fees matter (Myers), filed exceptions to the RO. Both Metz and Myers were provided by the Commission with notice of the date, time, and place of the Commission's September 9, 2011 consideration of the RO. Myers did not appear at the September 9 consideration by the Commission. Neither Metz nor Myers made any objection to the contents of the RO. The Commission adopted, in full, the RO of the ALJ.

Accordingly, pursuant to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes, and Section 112.317(7), Florida Statutes, the Commission adopts the RO of the ALJ as its Final Order (FO) and awards costs and attorney fees in favor of Metz and against Myers in the amounts of \$42,634.26 (attorney fees) and \$2,576.53 (costs).
