FINAL ORDER

An Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings has entered an Order Relinquishing Jurisdiction And Closing File in this proceeding.

BACKGROUND

This is a proceeding to determine whether a portion of Panama City (City)

Comprehensive Plan Amendment 10-2, adopted by Ordinance Nos. 2372.2 and 2383.1, on

October 26, 2010, is "in compliance" with the Community Planning Act, Ch. 163, Part II, Florida

Statutes (2011) (the "Act").

The Department of Community Affairs and the City entered into a Stipulated Settlement Agreement which required the City to adopt a certain remedial amendment. The City adopted Remedial Amendment 11-R1 by Ordinance Nos. 2418 and 2419 on May 24, 2011, and the Remedial Amendment was not challenged by a timely petition.

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The Parties subsequently filed a Joint Motion For Order Relinquishing Jurisdiction. The Administrative Law Judge issued his Order Relinquishing Jurisdiction And Closing File, and relinquished jurisdiction to the Department of Community Affairs.

Effective October 1, 2011, the state land planning agency duties, powers and functions of the Department of Community Affairs were transferred to the Department of Economic Opportunity.

ORDER

WHEREFORE, it is ORDERED that:

- A. Panama City Comprehensive Plan Amendment 10-2, as modified by Remedial Amendment 11-R1, is determined to be in compliance with the Act, and
 - B. The above-captioned proceeding is DISMISSED.
