FINAL ORDER

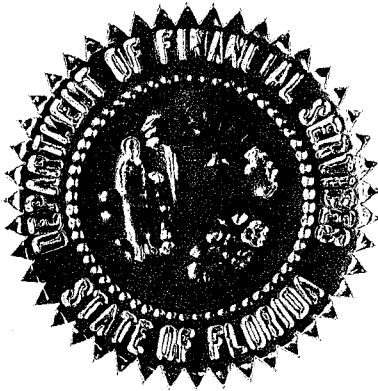
THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order rendered by Administrative Law Judge Susan B. Harrell on July 22, 2011, subsequent to a hearing held on June 10, 2011, in Tallahassee and Fort Myers, Florida, via video teleconference. No exceptions were filed.
