


Before the Education Practices Commission of the State of Florida



Final Order

This matter was heard by a Teacher Panel of the Education Practices Commission pursuant to Sections 1012.795, 1012.796 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on September 27, 2012, in Orlando, Florida, for consideration of the Recommended Order entered in this case by F. Scott Boyd, Administrative Law Judge dated May 31, 2012. Petitioner was not present.

Petitioner filed Exceptions to the Recommended Order. A copy of those Exceptions is attached to and incorporated by reference. After reviewing the complete record accompanying the Recommended Order, the Recommended Order, the Exceptions, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission rejected exception 1, finding that the administrative law judge's finding was more reasonable.
