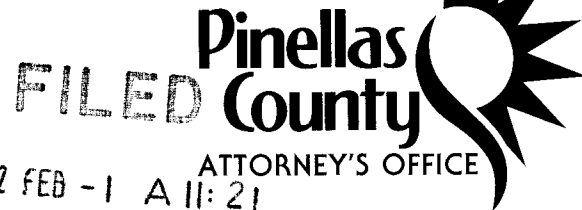

**FINAL ORDER**

The Sheriff's Civil Service Board, in accordance with the authority in the Special Act, Laws of Florida 89-904, as amended, elected by contract with the Department of Administrative Hearings (DOAH) to have the hearing on Petitioner's timely filed appeal conducted by a DOAH Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). Subsequent to that election but prior to the appeal hearing, Respondent requested this Board to withdraw that election and dismiss the appeal for lack of jurisdiction based on changed circumstances. A meeting was held January 27, 2012. Petitioner did not appear. Upon argument presented at the January 27, 2012 meeting, and being otherwise advised in the premises,

IT IS ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. The Board, by a unanimous vote of five (5) members, finds that it has been divested of jurisdiction to hear, or have DOAH conduct a hearing, on the Appeal of Shawn Fox and remands the appeal back to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Office.

2. The Board directs the parties to notify the DOAH ALJ of this Order within five (5) calendar days.


