FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order rendered by Administrative Law Judge Cathy M. Sellers, on January 30, 2012, subsequent to a hearing held on December 13, 2011, in West Palm Beach and Tallahassee, Florida, via video teleconference. No exceptions were filed.

After review of the record, including the transcript of proceedings and admitted exhibits, and being otherwise fully apprised in all material premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Door Depot of Palm Beach, Inc. (Door Depot) is assessed a penalty of \$16,213.30, and is due to the Department within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, or that the Department and Door Depot will execute a Payment Agreement Schedule for Periodic Payment of Penalty, pursuant to Florida Administrative Code Rule 69L-6.025, under which Door Depot shall make a down payment of ten percent of the total assessed penalty amount, which is in the amount of \$1,621.33, and pay the remaining penalty in 60 equal and consecutive monthly installments to the Department.

Default on any installment payment shall cause the remainder of the penalty to become immediately due and payable, and shall cause the Stop-Work Order to become effective as of the date of the default.
