FINAL ORDER REJECTING ALL BIDS AND DISMISSING PROTEST


Upon the filing of the Uncontested Motion to Relinquish Jurisdiction by the Department in this cause on January 6, 2012, Administrative Law Judge James H. Peterson, III, entered an Order Relinquishing Jurisdiction and Closing File on January 9, 2012.

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NOTICE OF RIGHTS



The notice of appeal must be filed within thirty days after this order is filed with the clerk of the Department. Failure to make a timely appeal will result in waiver of the right of judicial review in this matter.
