FINAL ORDER

This cause came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order filed on April 30, 2012, by Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Lynne A. Quimby-Pennock. A copy of that Recommended Order is attached as Exhibit A. On October 18, 2011, Department of Financial Services, Division of State Fire Marshal (Department) issued a letter to Christie Beverly (Beverly) indicating she did not receive a passing score on the "Firefighter Minimum Standards Practical Retest."

Pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, a formal hearing was conducted on March 12, 2012, before Administrative Law Judge Lynn A. Quimby-Pennock. No exceptions were filed.

After review of the record, including admitted exhibits, and being otherwise fully apprised in all material premises,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law. IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Christie Beverly's request to retest on the hose component of the practical portion of the firefighter examination is granted, and that her testing will be as if she were taking the retest within the six-month window for retest.
