FINAL ORDER

On October 28, 2010, the Department of Transportation (Department) issued a Notice of Intent to Permit Closure of a highway-rail grade crossing at SE 222nd Street in Hawthorne, Florida, to the rail operator, CSX Transportation, Inc. (CSX). On November 15, 2010, Petitioner, Shane Henry (Henry) filed a petition opposing the proposed closure. On November 17, 2010, the City of Hawthorne filed a petition opposing the proposed closure.

On May 30, 2012, the Department referred the petitions to the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH) for assignment of an Administrative Law Judge (ALJ). An Order of

Consolidation for the two individual petitions was entered June 12, 2012.

On July 30, 2012, the City of Hawthorne withdrew its petition challenging the crossing closure. On November 20 2012, the City of Hawthorne, CSX Transportation, Inc., and the Department of Transportation entered into a settlement agreement agreeing to the crossing closure with CSX and the Department to each provide a closure incentive cash payment of \$7,500.00 to the City of Hawthorne. The settlement agreement was contingent upon resolution of any remaining petitions in this cause and issuance of a final order approving of the closure.

A final hearing on the petition brought by Dr. Shane Henry was heard in Hawthorne, Florida, on August 3, 2012, before Administrative Law Judge Lawrence Stevenson. Appearances on behalf of the parties were as follows:

A transcript of the proceedings was filed on August 27, 2012. The Department filed a Proposed Recommended Order on September 25, 2012 and CSX filed a Proposed Recommended Order on October 2, 2012. Dr. Henry did not file a Proposed Recommended Order. The ALJ entered his Recommended Order on October 26, 2012, wherein he recommended the Department enter a final order approving the closure of the highway-railroad crossing located at SE 222nd Street, in Hawthorne, Florida. No exceptions have been filed.

STATEMENT OF THE ISSUE

The issue as presented in the Recommended Order is:

Whether the Department of Transportation may issue a permit authorizing CSX Transportation, Inc. to close the public railroad-highway grade crossing 627445-K (the "Crossing") located at SE 222nd Street in Hawthorne, Florida.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. By executing the Settlement Agreement, the City of Hawthorne has withdrawn its hearing request.
- 2. After review of the record in its entirety on the petition brought by Dr. Shane Henry, it is determined that the ALJ's Findings of Fact in paragraphs 1 through 30 of the Recommended Order in DOAH Case No. 12-1959, are supported by competent, substantial evidence and are adopted and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 3. The Department has jurisdiction over the subject matter of and the parties to this proceeding pursuant to Chapters 120 and 335, Florida Statutes.
- 4. The Conclusions of Law in paragraphs 31 through 40 of the Recommended Order in DOAH Case No. 12-1959, are fully supported in law, and are adopted and incorporated as if fully set forth herein.

ORDER

Based on the foregoing Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law, it is

ORDERED that the attached Settlement Agreement is approved and incorporated herein.

The Petition for Administrative Hearing filed by the City of Hawthorne is withdrawn. It is further

ORDERED that the Petition for Administrative Hearing filed by Shane Henry is DENIED. It is further,

ORDERED that Highway-Rail Grade Crossing Number 627445 K located at SE 222nd Street in Hawthorne, Florida, is to be closed by roadway removal.
