Your request to modify Construction Permit No. 40003983.000 and 44003983.008 by short form has been approved. This modification authorizes:

- 1. The construction of a building over existing pavement; the re-configuration of and addition to the existing parking lot; and the addition of a dumpster pad. The project drains to an existing off-site stormwater management pond that was authorized under Construction Permit No. 40003983.000. This pond is part of a master stormwater plan and was designed to serve the referenced site. The Engineer-of-Record provided calculations to demonstrate that the site's curve number (with the referenced additional impervious area) would be less than the curve number used in the original permitted pond design.
- 2. The sidewalk shown on the permitted plans in the US Highway 301 right-of-way is exempt from District permitting per Rule 40D-4.051(13)(a), F.A.C.
- 3. This permit modification replaces the previous permit modification for this site, Construction Permit No. 44003983.008, dated June 12, 2012, entitled Enterprise Project.
- 4. All other terms and conditions of Construction Permit No. 40003983.000, dated September 12, 1988, entitled "Brandon Auto Mall" apply.

Approved construction plans are part of the permit, and construction must be in accordance with these plans. These drawings are available for viewing or downloading through the District's Application and Permit Search Tools located at www.WaterMatters.org/permits.
