THIS MATTER has come before the undersigned for the purpose of issuing a final order pursuant to section 120.569(l), Florida Statutes.

DOAH PROCEEDINGS

The Petitioner, MICHAEL GLEN O'BRIEN, is a participant in the State's self-insured group health insurance plan, known as the "State Employees' PPO Plan" (State Plan), and he petitioned to contest the denial of benefits. As provided in section 110.123(3), Florida Statutes, the Division of State Group Insurance is responsible for the administration of the State Plan.

Petitioner requested that certain medical expenses be covered under the State Plan. DMS denied his Level II appeal for coverage. The Division of State Group Insurance considered the medical procedure to be experimental or investigational.

This matter was held in abeyance by the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), pending an external medical review. Based upon that report, the Petitioner chose to request a dismissal of his appeal.

On December 11, 2012, the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), Suzanne Van Wyk, issued an Order Closing File and Relinquishing Jurisdiction, see attachments.

Based upon the foregoing, it is **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED**:

- 1. A Final Order of Dismissal is entered and the appeal is dismissed in its entirety.
- 2. This Final Order shall become effective on the date of filing with the
