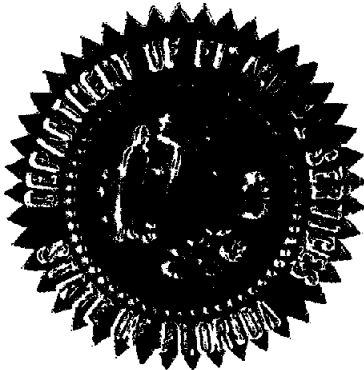
After a review of the record, including admitted exhibits, and considering applicable law, and otherwise being fully apprised in all material premises:

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law of the ALJ are adopted in full as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the ALJ's recommendation that a Final Order be entered affirming the Amended Order of Penalty Assessment issued by the Division of Workers' Compensation and imposing a penalty in the amount of \$ 2,272.31 are ACCEPTED.

ACCORDINGLY, it is ORDERED that the Amended Order of Penalty Assessment issued by the Division of Workers' Compensation is AFFIRMED and Barber Custom Builders, Inc. shall pay a penalty in the amount of \$ 2,272.31.
