FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of and final agency action on the Recommended Order rendered by Administrative Law Judge Robert S. Cohen (ALJ) on December 20, 2013, subsequent to a hearing held on November 5, 2013, in Tallahassee and Tampa, Florida, via video teleconference. No exceptions were filed.

After review of the record, including the transcript of proceedings and admitted exhibits, and being otherwise fully apprised in all material premises,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the ALJ's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order are adopted as the Department's Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Stop-work Order, and the Third Amended Order of Penalty Assessment is affirmed, assessing a penalty in the amount of \$42,251.43, against Mad Dog Marketing Group, Inc., (Mad Dog) and that Mad Dog is assessed an additional \$1,000.00 for each of the two days in violation of the Stop-work Order issued July 25, 2013, for a total penalty in amount of \$44,251.43 against Mad Dog Marketing Group, Inc., to be paid to the Department within thirty (30) days from the date hereof, or alternatively, that Mad Dog enter into a Payment Agreement Schedule for Periodic Payment of Penalty for said amount.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Mad Dog Marketing Group, Inc. shall cease all business operations unless and until it provides evidence satisfactory to the Division of Workers' Compensation of having now complied with the workers' compensation law by securing the necessary workers' compensation insurance coverage for covered employees and, pursuant to Section 440.107(7)(a), Florida Statutes, paying the civil penalty imposed herein.
