FINAL ORDER

This cause came before the State of Florida, Department of Revenue ("Department"), for the purpose of issuing a final order. On September 23, 2014, the Department issued an Amended Administrative Complaint ("Complaint") against Respondent. A true and correct copy of the Complaint is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit 1. The Complaint sought to revoke Respondent's certificate of registration, in accordance with Sections 212.18 and 213.692, Florida Statutes, due to Respondent's non-compliance with Chapter 212, Florida Statutes.

In response to the Complaint, Respondent elected a disputed fact hearing pursuant to Subsection 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, which was held on January 5, 2015. A true and correct copy of Respondent's request for hearing is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit 2. The Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH) issued its recommended order on January 30, 2015. A copy of the recommended order is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit 3. There were no exceptions filed by either party.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the findings of fact as set forth in the recommended order as the factual findings herein.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

The Department hereby adopts and incorporates by reference the conclusions of law as set forth in the recommended order as the conclusions of law herein.

That Respondent's Certificate of Registration, numbered 54-8013269710-0 is hereby revoked.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW

Any party who is adversely affected by this final order has the right to seek judicial review of the order under section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by filing a notice of appeal under Rule 9.190 of the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure with the Agency Clerk of the Department of Revenue in the Office of the General Counsel, Post Office Box 6668, Tallahassee, Florida 32314-6668 [FAX (850) 488-7112], **AND** by filing a **copy** of the notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the District

Court of Appeal, First District or with the District Court of Appeal in the appellate district where the party resides. The notice of appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this order is filed with the clerk of the Department.
