**FINAL ORDER OF THE SCHOOL BOARD
OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA**

THIS CAUSE having been heard by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, at its regular meeting of October 14, 2015, and upon the Recommended Order by the duly appointed Administrative Law Judge recommending that the School Board enter a Final Order reinstating Respondent to his position as a Teacher and awarding back-pay from October 7, 2014 until February 17, 2015. Subsequent to the Final Hearing on June 30, 2015 Respondent was terminated for failing to maintain a valid Teaching Certificate as such that portion of the Recommended Order reinstating Respondent to his previous employment is now moot since he is no longer qualified for employment as a teacher. It is thereupon ordered by The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida, that:

1. The Administrative Law Judge's findings of fact, conclusions of law be adopted as the Final Order of The School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida;
2. Respondent's will receive back pay for the period from October 7, 2014 until February 17, 2015;
3. Respondent is ineligible for employment with the District due to his lack of Teaching Certificate.
