FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Electrical Contractors' Licensing Board (Board) pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on May 14, 2015, in Daytona Beach, Florida, for the purpose of considering the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order, (attached hereto as Exhibit A) in the above-styled case. FINDINGS OF FACT

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

PENALTY

Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Board determines that the penalty recommended by the Administrative Law Judge be accepted.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that:

- 5. <u>Fine</u>. The Board shall impose an administrative fine in the amount of **one** thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) to be paid within ninety (90) days of the filing date of this Final Order.
- 6. <u>Continuing Education</u>. Within one (1) year of the filing date of this Final Order, Respondent shall attend two (2) hours of continuing education in the areas of the laws and rules governing the practice of electrical contracting. These continuing education hours are in addition to the hours required for license renewal.

This Final Order shall become effective upon filing with the Clerk for the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.
