FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the Electrical Contractors' Licensing Board (Board) pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on May 14, 2015, in Daytona Beach, Florida, for the purpose of considering the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order, (attached hereto as Exhibit A) in the above-styled case. Petitioner was represented by Daniel S. Brackett, Assistant Attorney General. Neither Respondent nor his counsel, Rosemary Hanna Hayes, Attorney at Law, was present. The Board was represented by Deborah Bartholow Loucks, Assistant Attorney General.

Upon review of the Recommended Order and of the complete record in this case, the Board makes the following findings and conclusions.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The findings of fact set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated by reference herein.

2. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact in the Recommended Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

3. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and Chapters 455, and 489, Florida Statutes.

4. The conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated by reference herein.

PENALTY

Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Board determines that the penalty recommended by the Administrative Law Judge be accepted.

THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that:


5. **Fine.** The Board shall impose an administrative fine in the amount of **one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00)** to be paid within **ninety (90) days** of the filing date of this Final Order.

6. **Continuing Education.** Within **one (1) year** of the filing date of this Final Order, Respondent shall attend **two (2) hours** of continuing education in the areas of the laws and rules governing the practice of electrical contracting. These continuing education hours are in addition to the hours required for license renewal.

This Final Order shall become effective upon filing with the Clerk for the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.

NOTICE OF RIGHT OF JUDICIAL REVIEW

A party who is adversely affected by this final order is entitled to judicial review pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes. Review proceedings are governed by the Florida rules of appellate procedure. Such proceedings are commenced by filing one copy of a notice of appeal with the agency clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation and a second copy, accompanied by filing fees prescribed by law, with the District Court of Appeal, First District, or with the District Court of Appeal in the Florida appellate district where the party resides. The notice of appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days of the filing date of the order to be reviewed.
