


Before the Education Practices Commission of the State of Florida



This matter was heard by a Teacher Panel of the Education Practices Commission pursuant to Sections 1012.795, 1012.796 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on October 29, 2015, in Tampa, Florida, for consideration of the Recommended Order entered in this case by J. Bruce Culpepper, Administrative Law Judge dated August 27, 2015. Respondent was not present.

Respondent filed exceptions to the Recommended Order. The exceptions do not identify any paragraphs of the Recommended Order to which he objects. Therefore, Respondent's objections do not constitute exceptions and are denied.

Respondent attempted to "establish a pattern" attacking the credibility of one of the witnesses. Judging the credibility of witnesses is in the purview of the administrative law judge. Therefore, the attempted exception is rejected.

Respondent objects to the admission of Exhibit 6. Admissibility of evidence is in the purview of the administrative law judge. Therefore, the attempted exception is rejected.

Respondent objects to the admission of evidence reflected on page 79 of the transcript of the hearing. Admissibility of evidence is in the purview of the administrative law judge. Therefore, the attempted exception is rejected.

After reviewing the complete record accompanying the Recommended Order, the Recommended Order, and being fully advised in the premises, the Commission hereby adopts the findings of fact, (paragraphs 1-19), conclusions of law, (paragraphs 20-28), and the recommendation contained in the Recommended Order. A copy of the Recommended Order, attached to and made a part hereof, is hereby adopted in full and becomes the Final Order of the Education Practices Commission.

It is therefore ORDERED that:

Respondent's Florida educator's certificate is hereby revoked for a period of 5 years from the date of this Final Order.

This Order takes effect upon filing with the Clerk of the Education Practices Commission.
