


## Before the Education Practices Commission of the State of Florida



This matter was heard by a Teacher Panel of the Education Practices Commission pursuant to Sections 1012.795, 1012.796 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on October 30, 2015, in Tampa, Florida, for consideration of the Recommended Order entered in this case by Lisa Shearer Nelson, Administrative Law Judge dated September 28, 2015. Respondent was not present.
