1. On September 2, 2015, the Department issued an Administrative Complaint, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "1".

2. On December 1, 2015, a hearing in this cause was held before the Honorable Robert E. Meale, Administrative Law Judge, Division of Administrative Hearings.

3. On February 8, 2016, Honorable Robert E. Meale issued a Recommended Order, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "2".


The Statement of the Issues, Preliminary Statement, Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation contained in the Recommended Order are hereby adopted *in toto* and incorporated herein by reference.

Based upon the foregoing, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises it is, hereby ORDERED that: for Respondent's violations of Section 509, Florida Statutes, and/or the rules promulgated thereto the following penalty is imposed:

1. Respondent shall pay a fine in the amount of \$1,875.00, due and payable to the Division of Hotels and Restaurants, 1940 North Monroe Street, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-1011, within thirty (30) calendar days of the date this Order is filed with the Agency Clerk.

2. This Final Order shall become effective on the date of filing with the Agency Clerk.

Review proceedings are governed by Rules 9.110 and 9.190, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. Such proceedings are commenced by filing one copy of a Notice of Appeal with the Department of Business and Professional Regulation, Attn: Ronda L. Bryan, Agency Clerk, 1940 North Monroe Street, Suite 92, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2203 and a second copy, accompanied by the filing fees prescribed by law, with the District Court of Appeal, First District, or with the District Court of Appeal in the Florida Appellate District where the party resides. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days of rendition of the order to be reviewed.
