WHEREAS, Petitioner appealed his termination to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Board (the "Board"); and

WHEREAS, the appeal was transmitted to the Department of Administrative Hearing's Administrative Law Judge for evidentiary hearing and recommended order; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner Mathew Stanfield filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal without Prejudice; and

WHEREAS, the Administrative Law Judge issued an order, attached hereto and incorporated by reference, closing its file on the appeal and relinquishing jurisdiction to the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Board; and

WHEREAS, on September 28, 2016, the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Board met at a duly noticed meeting and being advised of the Administrative Law Judge's order and reviewing the same voted to dismiss Mathew Stanfield's appeal by a vote of 5 to 0.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is ordered and adjudged that:

1. The Board by a unanimous vote of five (5) members hereby dismisses the appeal of Mathew Stanfield.
2. The parties are hereby notified of the right to appeal this Final Order to the Second District Court of Appeals by filing a notice of intent to do so upon the Clerk of Court and the Board within thirty (30) days of the date of this order.


