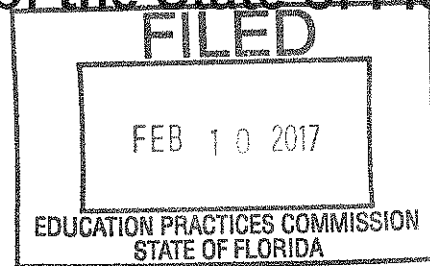

Final Order

This matter was heard by a Teacher Panel of the Education Practices Commission pursuant to Sections 1012.795, 1012.796 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on January 20, 2017 in Tallahassee, Florida, for consideration of the Recommended Order entered in this case by E. GARY EARLY, Administrative Law Judge.

Findings of Fact
