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# FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the State of Florida, Agency for Health Care Administration ("the Agency") concerning the preliminary denial of Certificate of Need ("CON") 10402 filed by CCRC-Freedom Pointe At The Villages, LLC, d/b/a Freedom Pointe At The Villages Rehabilitation And Healthcare Center ("Freedom Pointe"), to add 50 community nursing home beds through the conversion of 50 sheltered nursing home beds and a partial request to add 16 community nursing home beds through the conversion of 16 sheltered nursing home beds to Sub-District 3-7.

- 1. On February 19, 2016, the Agency preliminarily denied CON 10402.
- On March 11, 2016, Freedom Point filed a Petition for Formal Administrative 2. Hearing to contest the denial of CON 10402.
- 3. The Agency referred the Petition to the Division of Administrative Hearings and an Administrative Law Judge ("ALJ") was assigned.
- 4. On August 30, 2016, Freedom Pointe filed a Notice of Voluntary Dismissal dismissing its challenge to the denial of CON 10402.

5. Thereafter, the ALJ entered an Order Closing File and Relinquishing Jurisdiction.

#### It is therefore **ORDERED**:

1. The denial of CON 10402 is UPHELD.
