PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND

- 1. On November 4, 2016, the City of Tampa General Employees' Retirement Fund ("the Board") filed a request with the State of Florida Division of Administrative Hearings ("DOAH") to have this matter assigned to an Administrative Law Judge for submission of recommended findings to the Board regarding whether Beverly A. Harvin's pension benefits should be forfeited pursuant to section 112.3173, Fla. Stat.
- 2. On March 3, 2017, Linzie F. Bogan, Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings, conducted the final hearing.
- 3. On April 24, 2017, Judge Bogan submitted his Recommended Order recommending that forfeiture not take place. The Recommended Order included findings of fact and conclusions of law in support of the recommendation.
- 4. On June 20, 2017, the Board voted to adopt the Recommended Order as the final order of the Board.

ORDER

Based upon the adopted Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law found in the Recommended Order, it is hereby ORDERED that all rights, privileges and benefits to which Beverly A. Harvin, or any beneficiary claiming through her, is or may be entitled from the City of Tampa General Employees' Retirement Fund shall not be forfeited pursuant to Fla. Stat.
