FINAL ORDER

- 3. The Department has jurisdiction over this matter pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statues, and Chapters 455 and 475, Part I, Florida Statutes.
- 4. The Administrative Law Judge's conclusions of law as set forth in Exhibit A are approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference.
- 5. There is competent, substantial evidence to support the Administrative Law Judge's conclusions of law in Exhibit A as adopted by the Department.

6. The Administrative Law Judge's Recommendation is approved and adopted by the Department in its entirety.
