- (2) Respondent shall pay a fine in the amount of \$3,000.00, due and payable to the Division of Pari-Mutuel Wagering, Department of Business and Professional Regulation, 2601 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399, within thirty (30) calendar days of the date this Final Order is filed with the Agency Clerk.
  - (3) This Final Order shall become effective on the date of filing with the Agency Clerk.
