## FINAL ORDER

This matter comes before the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles upon Petitioners' Notice of Voluntary Dismissal with Prejudice filed August 27, 2021. The petitions in this matter were originally filed March 16, 2017, and the Department referred the petitions to the Division of Administrative Hearings on March 21, 2017. By Order of Consolidation, dated March 31, 2017, the cases styled above were consolidated with a third case. Before a date was set for the formal hearing, the parties filed a Joint Motion to Relinquish Jurisdiction to Agency on April 6, 2017, seeking an opportunity for the parties to engage in settlement negotiations.

On April 7, 2017, the Honorable J. Lawrence Johnston, Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings, issued an Order Closing Files and Relinquishing Jurisdiction. At the request of the parties, since that date, the cases have remained in abeyance before the Department while the parties have engaged in settlement negotiations.
