FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came before the State of Florida, Agency for Health Care Administration (“the Agency”) concerning the denial of Certificate of Need (“CON”) Application No. 10470 filed by Comprehensive Home Health Care, Inc. d/b/a OpusCare of South Florida (“OpusCare”) to establish new freestanding inpatient hospice facility consisting of 13 beds.

1. The Agency Notice denying OpusCare’s CON Application was published on February 20, 2016 in the Florida Administrative Register.


2. On March 6, 2017, OpusCare filed a Petition for Formal Administrative Proceeding contesting the Agency’s denial of its CON application. The cause was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings.

3. The parties have since entered into a Settlement Agreement (Exhibit 1) approving CON Application No. 10470. (Ex. 1)

It is therefore **ORDERED:**

1. The Agency shall issue CON No. 10470 to OpusCare pursuant to the terms of the parties’ settlement agreement.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW

A party who is adversely affected by this Final Order is entitled to judicial review, which shall be instituted by filing the original Notice of Appeal with the Agency Clerk of AHCA, and a copy along with the filing fee prescribed by law with the District Court of Appeal in the appellate district where the Agency maintains its headquarters or where a party resides. Review of proceedings shall be conducted in accordance with the Florida appellate rules. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days of the rendition of the order to be reviewed.
