SCHOOL BOARD FINAL ORDER

Pursuant to notice, final hearing was conducted on July 25, 2017 before the Division of Administrative Hearings by Administrative Law Judge Yolanda Y. Green. The subject matter of the hearing was whether there was just cause to discipline Respondent with a one-day unpaid suspension as a result of an incident on February 9, 2017 at Clermont Middle School.

Judge Green issued a Recommended Order on September 5, 2017. Judge Green determined that the Superintendent did have just cause to discipline Respondent and recommended that the School Board enter a Final Order approving the one-day unpaid suspension.

No exceptions were timely filed by either party.

Pursuant to §120.57, Florida Statutes, the School Board adopts the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law contained in the Recommended Order attached hereto as Exhibit "A."

Based on the foregoing, the School Board hereby upholds the determination of the Administrative Law Judge and accepts the recommendation of the Superintendent to discipline Respondent with a one-day unpaid suspension.
