**FINAL ORDER**

This matter having come before the Division of Administrative Hearings upon a settlement agreement between the parties and Joint Motion to Relinquish Jurisdiction, filed November 2, 2017, the matter is now before the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles for entry of a final order upon submission of the Order Closing File and Relinquishing Jurisdiction issued November 6, 2017, by the Honorable Cathy M. Sellers, Administrative Law Judge of the Division of Administrative Hearings, a copy of which is attached and incorporated by reference in this order.

The Department hereby adopts and incorporates the Settlement Agreement into this final order, suspends Tri-County Driving Schools license # 4060 for ten (10) days commencing on November 17, 2017 and continuing through November 26, 2017, and makes the following findings of fact:

1. Tri-County Driving School solicited business on property used by the Department to issue driver licenses on March 29, 2017.
2. Tri-County Driving School solicited business on property used by the Department to issue driver licenses on March 30, 2017.
3. Tri-County Driving School solicited business on property used by the Department to issue driver licenses on April 6, 2017.
4. Tri-County Driving School solicited business on property used by the Department to issue driver licenses on April 27, 2017.
5. Tri-County Driving School solicited business on property used by the Department to issue driver licenses on May 10, 2017.
6. Tri-County Driving School solicited business on property used by the Department to issue driver licenses on May 11, 2017.
7. Tri-County Driving School solicited business on property used by the Department to issue driver licenses on May 15, 2017.

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that Tri-County Driving Schools license # 4060 is suspended for ten (10) days and further this case is **CLOSED**.

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**NOTICE OF APPEAL RIGHTS**

A party adversely affected by this final order may seek judicial review as provided in section 120.68, Florida Statutes, and Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.190. Judicial review is initiated by filing a notice of appeal with the Agency Clerk, and a copy of the notice of appeal, accompanied by the filing fee, with the appropriate district court of appeal. The notice of appeal must conform to the requirements of Florida Rule of Appellate Procedure 9.110(d) and must be filed (*i.e.*, received by the Agency Clerk) within thirty days of rendition of this final order.
