**FINAL ORDER**

This matter, having come before the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Board on September 25, 2018, sitting as a quasi-judicial body, and the Board having reviewed the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order, transcript of the hearing, the parties' written exceptions and responses thereto, having heard oral argument and being otherwise advised in the premises, it is:

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that:

1. By a vote of 5-0, the Board rejects all Respondent's Exceptions.
2. The Board, by a vote of 5-0 hereby accepts all Findings of Fact in the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order.
3. The Board, by a vote of 5-0, accepts all Conclusions of Law in the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order.
4. The Board, by a vote of 5-0 finds:
  - a. The member engaged in the prohibited conduct for which she was disciplined; and

b. The penalty imposed was consistent with action taken against other members for the prohibited conduct.

5. The Board, therefore, sustains the dismissal of Respondent for cause.

6. The parties are hereby notified of the right to appeal this Final Order to the Second District Court of Appeal by filing notice of intent to do so upon the Clerk of Court and the Pinellas County Sheriff's Civil Service Board within thirty (30) days of the date of this Final Order.


