**FINAL ORDER**

THIS CAUSE came on to be heard before the Department of Financial Services, Board of Funeral, Cemetery and Consumer Services (“Respondent” or “Board”), pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, on December 6, 2018, in Jacksonville, Duval County, Florida, for the purposes of considering Administrative Law Judge Yolonda Y. Green’s Recommended Order in the above styled case. A copy of said Recommended Order is attached hereto and incorporated as Exhibit “A.”

Petitioner was not present and was not represented by counsel.

After a review of the complete record in this matter, including consideration of the Administrative Law Judge’s Recommended Order and arguments, the Board makes the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

**Findings of Fact**

1. The Administrative Law Judge’s findings of fact as set forth in the Exhibit “A” are approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference.

2. There is competent, substantial evidence to support the Administrative Law Judge's findings of fact as adopted by the Board.

**Conclusions of Law**

3. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, Chapter 497, Florida Statutes, and Rule Chapter 69K, Florida Administrative Code.

4. The Administrative Law Judge's conclusions of law as set forth in Exhibit "A" are approved, adopted, and incorporated herein by reference.

5. There is competent, substantial evidence to support the Administrative Law Judge's conclusions of law in Exhibit "A" adopted by the Board.

**DISPOSITION**

6. The Administrative Law Judge's Recommendation is approved and adopted by the Board.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED and ADJUDGED that:

Petitioner's application for a preneed sales agent license is hereby DENIED. This Final Order shall take effect upon being filed with the Clerk of the Department of Financial Services.



A party who is adversely affected by this final order is entitled to judicial review pursuant to section 120.68, Florida Statutes. Review proceedings are governed by the Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure. Such proceedings are commenced by filing one copy of a Notice of Appeal with the agency clerk of the Department of Financial Services and a second copy, accompanied by filing fees prescribed by law, with the district court of appeal in the appellate district where the party resides. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within thirty (30) days of rendition of the order to be reviewed.
