FINAL ORDER

THIS MATTER came before the Construction Industry Licensing Board (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") pursuant to Sections 120.569 and 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, at a duly-noticed public meeting on January 10, 2019, in Ponte Vedra Beach, Florida, for consideration of the Honorable F. Scott Boyd's Recommended Order issued on October 18, 2018 (attached hereto as Exhibit "A").

Upon review of the Recommended Order, and having heard argument of the parties and after a review of the complete record in this case, the Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

EXCEPTIONS

1. Neither Respondent nor Petitioner filed Exceptions to the Recommended Order's Findings of Fact.

FINDINGS OF FACT

2. There is competent, substantial evidence to support the Findings of Fact made in the Recommended Order.

3. Accordingly, the Findings of Fact set forth in the Recommended Order are hereby approved, adopted, and incorporated by reference as the Findings of Fact of the Board.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

4. The Board has personal and subject matter jurisdiction of this cause pursuant to sections 120.569; 120.57(1); and Chapters 455; 489, *Florida Statutes*.

5. The Board does not find a more reasonable interpretation of the law than that which was found by the Administrative Law Judge.

6. Accordingly, the Conclusions of Law set forth in the Recommended Order are approved, adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

WHEREFORE, based on the Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law, the Administrative Law Judge's Recommendation is **ACCEPTED**.

WHEREFORE, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **ADJUDGED** that the following penalty is imposed against the Respondent:

Respondent's license as a certified residential contractor is hereby **REVOKED**.

This Final Order shall become effective upon filing with the Clerk of the Department of Business and Professional Regulation.
