FINAL ORDER

Sections 120.569 and 120.57 (1), Florida Statutes, at the properly noticed meeting on January 28 and 29, 2019, in Orlando, Florida, for the purpose of considering the Administrative Law Judge's Recommended Order (RO), (a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit A) in the above-styled cause. Petitioner was represented by Christina Shideler, Assistant General Counsel. Neither Respondent nor his Counsel were present at the meeting.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

- 1. In May 2018, the Department of Health (DOH) filed an Administrative Complaint against Respondent, Fengyan Liu.
- 2. The case was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearing (DOAH) and a hearing on was held on June 4, 2018.
- 3. Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), Yolanda Green, issued Recommended Order on November 16, 2018.

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- 4. Respondent was represented by Richard A. Brown and Estell Reginald, and the Department was represented by Derrick McBurrows.
 - 5. No exceptions the Recommended Order were filed.
- 6. The Board considered the Recommended Order; and after a review of the complete record in this case; the Board makes the following findings and conclusions:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 7. There is competent substantial evidence to support the findings of fact.
- 8. The findings of fact set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 9. The Board has jurisdiction of this matter pursuant to Section 120.57(1), Florida Statutes, and Chapter 464, Florida Statutes.
- 10. The conclusions of law set forth in the Recommended Order are approved and adopted and incorporated herein by reference.

PENALTY

11. Upon a complete review of the record in this case, the Board determines that the recommendation of the Administrative Law Judge is ACCEPTED.

WHEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED:

12. The license of Fengyan Liu is REVOKED. Within 30 days the licensee shall return the license to DOH-Compliance Unit, 4052 Bald

Cypress Way, Bin C-76, Tallahassee, FL 32399, Attention: Massage Therapy Compliance Officer. The licensee's employer shall immediately be informed of the revocation in writing from the licensee with a copy to the Board of fice.

The licensee must pay an administrative fine of \$2,500 and investigative costs and attorney fees of \$20,864.04, to be paid at the rate of \$4,672.81 per year, with the first payment due 1 year from the date of filing of this Final Order. Payment shall be made to the Board of Massage Therapy and mailed to, DOH-Compliance Management Unit, 4052 Bald Cypress Way, Tallahassee, Florida 32399, Attention: Massage Therapy Compliance Officer. Payment must be made by cashier's check or money order ONLY. | Personal checks will not be accepted.

This Final Order shall become effective upon filing with the Clerk of the Department of Health.
