
FINAL ORDER

This matter comes before the Department for consideration of a Joint Settlement Agreement and Petitioner Spring Oaks Greenhouses, Inc.'s voluntary dismissal. On July 30, 2018, Petitioner filed a petition seeking licensure as a medical marijuana treatment center. The petition was referred to the Division of Administrative Hearings on August 24, 2018. On October 18, 2018, Administrative Law Judge G. W. Chisenhall issued an order relinquishing jurisdiction to the Department of Health. On April 16, 2019, the parties entered into a Joint Settlement Agreement, which is attached as Exhibit A to this Final Order and incorporated by reference. On April 17, 2019, Petitioner filed a voluntary dismissal with prejudice. The Department has issued a letter, which is attached Exhibit B and incorporated by reference, licensing Spring Oaks Greenhouses, Inc. as a medical marijuana treatment center.

Based on the foregoing, the Petition is hereby dismissed with prejudice. This matter is closed.

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
