THIS CAUSE is before the State of Florida, Agency for Health care Administration ("the Agency") concerning the preliminary denial of the application for a certificate of need ("CON") 10541 filed by Sunrise Community, Inc. ("Sunrise) seeking to establish a 24-bed Intermediate Care Facility for the Developmentally Disabled to be located in Hardee County, Service Area 6.

- 1. On August 20, 2018, the Agency published a notice in the Florida Administrative Register of its decision to deny Sunrise's application for CON 10541.
