FINAL ORDER AWARDING FEES AND COSTS

This Final Order Awarding Fees and Costs issues in accordance with the Joint Stipulation for Attorneys' Fees and Costs and as authorized by section 120.595(3), Florida Statutes (2021). - 4. The sum of \$2,456.80 for costs must be paid directly to Petitioners and provided in care of GrayRobinson, P.A.

Respondent must seek immediate approval for payment and make payment within 60 days of the date of this Final Order.
