FINAL ORDER

THIS CAUSE came on for consideration of and for final agency action on a Recommended Order.

After reviewing the record, including all testimony and admitted exhibits, considering applicable law, and otherwise being fully apprised in all material premises, the Recommended Order is hereby adopted with the following modification: The first sentence of Conclusions of Law paragraph 28 is modified by replacing it with the following: "A request for an administrative hearing occurs when the request is filed with the Department's agency clerk during normal business hours." Paragraph 28's description of how the filing of a request for hearing occurs is broader than the language used in the rule it cites as authority for the conclusion. The modified conclusion of law, which is more narrowly tailored, is as or more reasonable than the conclusion it replaces.

Accordingly, Respondent's petition for a hearing is dismissed as untimely.
