FINAL ORDER AWARDING FEES AND COSTS

This Final Order Awarding Fees and Costs issues in accordance with the Joint Stipulation for Attorneys' Fees and Costs and as authorized by section 120.595(3), Florida Statutes (2021). By their Joint Stipulation, the parties fully resolve claims for attorneys' fees and costs in Division of Administrative Hearings Case Numbers 19-4688RP and 19-4913RP and related appeals in First District Court of Appeal Case Numbers 1D19-4599 and 1D20-0004.

Petitioners are awarded \$123,010.00 in attorneys' fees and \$7,407.38 in costs. Respondent must pay these fees and costs as follows:

3. The sum of \$2,407.38 for costs must be paid directly to Petitioners and provided in care of Komisar Spicola, P.A.

4. The sum of \$5,000 for costs must be paid directly to Petitioners and provided in care of Greenberg Traurig, P.A.

5. Respondent must seek immediate approval for payment and make payment within 60 days of the date of this Final Order.
